

Detailed Itinerary

9 March'25, Sunday

Arrive Delhi

This morning after breakfast, embark on a scenic morning drive to Agra, where a world of wonders awaits you.


Upon arrival, check in at your hotel.

In the afternoon, experience 'Gulal Gota,' a rare art form from Jaipur, involves creating small, colorful balls for the Hindu festival of Holi. Master artist Awaaz Mohammad, who has practiced this craft for seven decades, along with his family, preserves this 400-year-old legacy. This quaint workshop, demonstrates the intricate process: artisans use fire and copper rods to blow lac into delicate hollow balls, which are then filled with fragrant herbal gulal and sealed with paper. These eco-friendly, handcrafted balls burst with color when thrown, symbolizing communal harmony as they are made by Muslim artisans for a Hindu festival. This tradition is still embraced by royals and used in temples, adding a heritage touch to celebrations.

14 March'25, Friday


