



1 December'24, Sunday

Arrive Delhi

In Delhi

Enjoy a rickshaw ride through the bustling streets of Chandni Chowk, visit Jama Masjid, a masterpiece of Mughal architecture, its grandeur is reflected in the vast courtyard and imposing red sandstone structure, offering a serene space for spiritual reflection.

Take a break to savor a delectable early lunch at the majestic Haveli Dharampura.

Before returning to the hotel, explore the exquisite Bangla Sahib, a place of great spiritual significance, where you can immerse yourself in the peaceful and serene atmosphere. Next visit Qutub Minar, a UNESCO World Heritage site in Delhi, gracefully pierces the sky with its 73-meter sandstone tower, narrating tales of ancient craftsmanship and historical significance.

Early this morning, you will take a train to Agra.


Agra is still associated with its Mughal period. The Mughals besides being great rulers were also great builders and they preserved their best architectural wonders for Agra & its neighborhood.

Later visit the iconic Taj Mahal at sunset. Take in the breathtaking beauty of the white-marble Mughal architecture as you stroll around and capture stunning photos with the Taj as your backdrop. You can also watch the Yamuna River flowing behind the Taj.

5 December'24, Thursday


Delhi - Jaipur

Embark on a cultural journey in Jaipur with a visit to the City Palace, a majestic blend of Rajput and Mughal architecture, showcasing exquisite courtyards, palatial structures, and a remarkable museum. Adjacent to the palace, the Laxmi Narayan Temple, also known as Birla Mandir, captivates with its intricate carvings and serene surroundings, offering a peaceful retreat amidst the vibrant cityscape. Explore the rich history and spirituality encapsulated in these iconic landmarks.

6 December'24, Friday

In Jaipur

This morning, visit the magnificent Amber Fort, which was built in the 16th century. Experience a jeep ride up to the fort. Sightseeing this morning involves 2–3 hours on foot and there are a number of steps within the fort.

This afternoon, visit the fascinating Jantar Mantar, the ancient astronomical observatory built by the Maharaja of Jaipur. Also see Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), built in the 18th century. Later explore the many facets of Jaipuri crafts such as semi precious jewels, colourful fabrics, woven carpets etc – watch artisans at work and enjoy souvenir shopping in this colourful city of Jaipur.

Later in the evening, enjoy a Hi- Tea at Rambagh Palace, located in the heart of Jaipur, is a stunning palace-turnedhotel known for its luxurious ambiance and rich heritage. The Hi-Tea experience here is a lavish affair, featuring delectable treats and refreshments served in a regal setting.

This morning after an early breakfast you will proceed to the airport to board a flight to Jodhpur. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in Jodhpur, the second largest city of Rajasthan, which was founded in 1459 A.D. by Rao Jodha. The rest of the day will be at leisure.

Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

9 December'24, Monday

In Jodhpur

After a relaxed breakfast, visit the rock-solid Mehrangarh Fort, and the grand palaces within the fort – Moti Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sileh Khana and Daulat Khana, which are impressive examples of architectural excellence. Near the fort complex stands the Jaswant Thada, and a group of royal cenotaphs made of white marble. While in Jodhpur shop for the exquisite handcrafted articles such as embroidered shoes, metal curios, silverware, paintings and tie and dye fabrics.

Also visit Umaid Bhavan Palace Museum - built by Maharaja Umaid Singh (1929 – 1942) and named after him, this exquisite Palace is also known as Chittar Palace because of the local chittar sandstone used in its construction. This palace is a splendid example of Indo-colonial and art deco architecture of the 1930s.

10 December'24, Tuesday


Jodhpur – Narlai

After breakfast you will be driven to Narlai.

Upon arrival in Narlai, check-in to your hotel.

Prepare for a memorable evening with a "Step Well Dinner" experience. A truly an experience that would linger in the fringes of your mind. Taste the flavor of true Rajasthani royal hospitality at the 16th Century old Baori (Step-well) of Rawla Narlai. The journey that begins when you gather at the courtyard, sip a welcome drink with the resident royal who will regale you with stories & history of the locals while you get adorned with the turbans & scarf and transportation by bullock carts are arranged for you. Guided by a local into the dusk, swaying to the movement of the cart, watching the village slowly going to sleep and the starlit sky unfolding above you, passing the yogi who meditates by the blazing fire, you reach your destination that is lit by hundreds of lamps. Following this experience is the culinary journey that ignites your taste buds with elaborate fare offered over the next couple of hours while being entertained by the local jogi singing the devotional folk songs in his rich melodious voice. This culinary experience ends with the return to the hotel courtyard by our jeeps and a welcome cup of calming herbal tea.

Narlai - Udaipur

After an early breakfast, embark on a scenic drive to the enchanting city of Udaipur.

Visit the intricately carved Ranakpur Jain Temples, featuring the Chaumukha Temple dedicated to Adinath with 29 halls, 1444 pillars, and two other notable Jain temples and a Sun Temple nearby.

As the journey continues towards Udaipur, let the beauty of the surroundings fill your senses. Upon arrival in this magical city, revel in a warm welcome and check-in to your hotel

Overnight: Taj Fateh Prakash, Udaipur


12 December'24, Thursday
